



## M. Bridget Reidy

EVP, Chief Operating Officer Exelon BSC

### Profile

As executive vice president & chief operating officer of Exelon Business Services Company (BSC), Reidy is responsible for Exelon's information and technology function; corporate and information security services; real estate and facilities; transportation department; and supply operations and sourcing for Atlantic City Electric, BGE, ComEd, Delmarva Power, PECO, Pepco, and BSC.

### Professional History

Prior to her current position, Reidy served as senior vice president and chief supply officer of Exelon and oversaw supply operations and sourcing as well as real estate for the enterprise. Before that, she served as senior vice president of customer operations for Exelon Energy Delivery, where she was responsible for all customer operations, including customer care, meter reading, meter services, billing and revenue collection for ComEd and PECO. She also served as senior vice president of Exelon BSC and chief supply officer at Exelon, where she was responsible for optimizing the company supply chain by improving processes and leveraging Exelon purchasing power. In a prior role as deputy general counsel of client services for Exelon BSC legal services, Reidy focused on management of the corporate law department, process improvement and integration of legal services. She also served as interim president of Exelon BSC and senior vice president of Exelon BSC services and operations, launching the realignment of Exelon's information technology and supply organizations.

From 1999 to 2001, Reidy was chief operating officer of the Chicago Housing Authority, where she led the negotiation, planning, coordination and implementation of the agency's Plan for Transformation. Prior to that, she served as deputy chief of staff to Chicago Mayor Richard M. Daley, coordinating major projects including Millennium Park, the McCormick Place expansion and the Soldier Field negotiations. As director of lakefront services for the Chicago Park District from 1994 to 1998, Reidy was responsible for the operations of 27 miles of lakefront, Soldier Field, four underground parking garages, surface parking, nine harbors, six golf courses, two driving ranges, concessions and sponsorship throughout the Park District.

Previously, Reidy served as an attorney with the commercial law department of Jenner & Block.

### Industry Leadership

Reidy is a founding executive member of the Electric Utility Industry Sustainable Supply Chain Alliance, which was formed to improve sustainability in electric utility industry supply chains. The Alliance develops voluntary standards for evaluating the environmental attributes of materials and services provided to the electric utility industry; the environmental performance of industry suppliers; and the environmental performance of electric utilities' supply chain operations.

### **Civic Involvement**

Reidy is a Board member for EIM (Energy Insurance Mutual), Navy Pier and a PGA Reach Trustee. She is also a member of the Regional Board for the American Ireland Funds.

### **Education**

Reidy holds a bachelor's degree in political science from the University of Illinois and a Juris Doctor degree from DePaul University College of Law.
